O bone Jesu

Marc'Antonio Ingegneri (c.1535 or 1536-1592)

- Renaissance composer (Italy)
- teacher of Claudio Monteverdi
- stylistically similar to Palestrina, Roman School of polyphonic church music

This motet has been wrongly attributed to Palestrina and only recently been identified as a work by Ingegneri. It was common during the time for lesser composers to attach the name of a more well known composer to their music in the hopes of recognition.

O bone Jesu, miserere nostri/nobis, quia tu creasti nos, tu redemisti nos sanguine tuo pretiosissimo.

O good Jesus, have mercy upon us, for thou hast created us, thou hast redeemed us by thy most precious blood.
